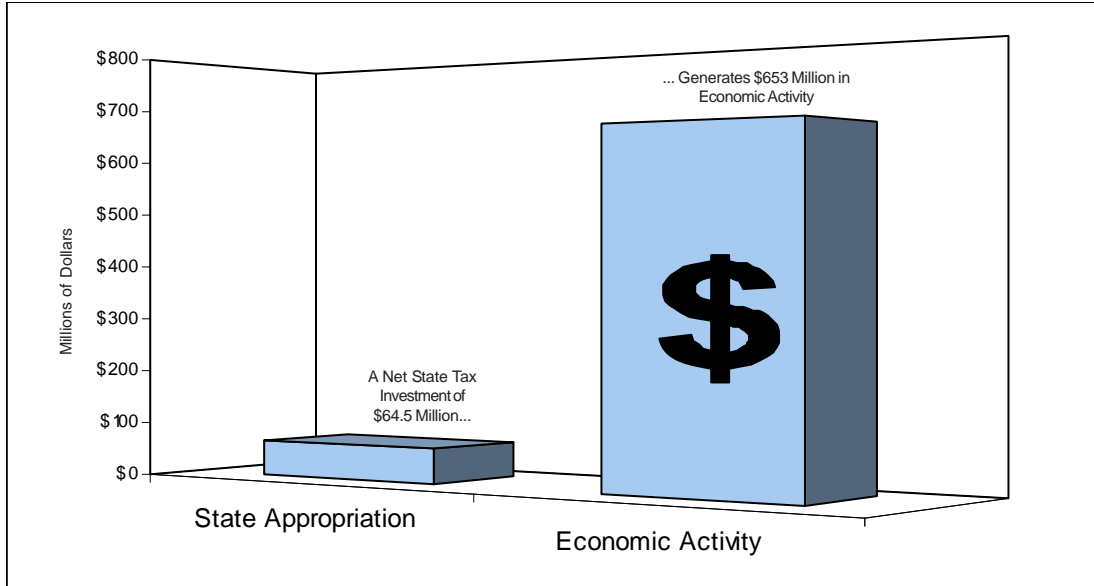


## UO Impact On The Economy

### The University of Oregon fuels the economic growth of Oregon

with research grants and contracts, federal financial aid, out-of-state student spending, private gifts, construction contracts, intercollegiate and national athletic events, and cultural events.

It is also the **largest employer in Lane County.**



### Adding Up The Contributions Statewide:

(For Fiscal Year 2005-6)

Employee Payroll	\$299 million
Materials and Supplies	130 million
Construction Contracts	45 million
Student Spending <sup>1</sup>	<u>179 million</u>
<b>Total</b>	<b>\$653 million</b>

***UO employees generated \$12.8 million in state income taxes in 2005-6***

### A Good Customer

In 2005-6, the university conducted business with nearly **7,190 vendors** spending **over \$154.9 million dollars.**  
*(\$89.7 million with Oregon vendors.)*

92% of those vendors were small businesses.
